CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY

- 1. Ngagaka Water and Sanitation Company Regulations as from time to time amended shall be deemed to be incorporated in and to form part of these conditions of supply.
- 2. Applications for the execution of works will as a rule be dealt with in the order of priority of date, but the right of executing the work in the manner and at the time best suited to his convenience.
- 3. All charges shall be payable on demand
- 4. If any account is overdue the water supply may be cut off under the provision of the NGAWASCO Rules and proceedings taken to recover the charges due.
- 5. Any changes in the charges shall be notified in the Gazette, and in addition details thereof shall be sent to each customer with the monthly account preceding such change.
- 6. NGAWASCO shall have the right forthwith and without notice to terminate the agreement for any breach by the customer of the conditions of supply, but without prejudice to any antecedent right against the customer including the right to take proceedings.
- 7. a) No customer shall use, or permit to be used any water supplied in pursuance of an application made by him under these Regulations except for such use as specified by him in his application.
 - b) No customer shall convey, or permit to be conveyed by any means whatsoever, for use outside his plot, or for sale, any water supplied to him by the NGAWASCO.
- 8. In accordance with Regulations the customer shall deposit an amount stipulated in the Kenya Gazette notice which shall be retained by the NGAWASCO for the period during which the customer is supplied with water.
- 9. The customer shall meet all charges in respect of water supplied in pursuance of this application and Customer Agreement until such time as the supply is disconnected pursuant to a written request made by him.
- 10. The customer shall not remove for any duration nor interfere with the water meter in whichever way, and shall only undertake plumbing works after the meter. Any water that leaks after the meter shall be the responsibility of the customer, but works from the meter towards the main shall be the duty of NGAWASCO.
- 11. Customers shall ensure that the water meter supplied is secured and should it be willfully damaged, or stolen shall meet the cost of a new meter to NGAWASCO.
